New Company Certification

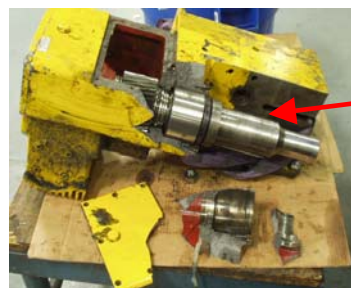
